



I DON'T NEED A PARACHUTE... TO LAND IN EUROPE
Summer School on European Integration - 22 – 29 July 2012

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PRACTICAL INFORMATIONS

1. How should I prepare for the Summer school?

➤ *How's the weather?*

In this period, you will find in Iasi town (the city of the Summer school) high temperatures, over 30 degree Celsius (between 30 and 35) in the mid day and around 20 degree Celsius in the night.

➤ *What should I put in my luggage?*

There will be a sportive event organized during the Summer school (football, basketball and handball). If you intend to participate, take it into consideration when you make your luggage. Even if it is very hot, you should also take with you a sweater if the weather changes.

There will be wireless internet in the rooms. You can take your laptops. There is not cable internet.

➤ *Should I take some pocket money with me?*

Yes. It is strongly advisable. The Summer school ensures transportation costs in some limits, accommodation, 3 meals per day, coffee-breaks during the courses and work-shops and other facilities.

However, it is strongly advisable to come with a sufficient amount of money for little purchases you may do during the Summer school (ice-cream, juices, souvenirs, local transportation, museums, etc.)

Those who must receive money for reimbursement should expect to receive only the equivalent of the costs incurred from their homeland to the Summer school and not the future cost of the return trip.

We will do our best to reimburse the money as quickly as possible. For some of you it may take some time to process the documents. We hope the reimbursement process will be finished by Tuesday evening.

It is better not to count on money for transport reimbursement on the first minute of your arrival.

2. I've arrived in Iasi. How do I get to the Summer school location?

If you arrived in Iasi by train, you will find a lot of Taxis outside the Railway station.

If you arrive in Iasi by plain, you will find a lot of Taxis outside the Airport awaiting for passengers.

Indicate the taxi driver the address mentioned bellow.

It should not cost you more than 15 Lei (Romanian currency) or 3 Euros from the Railway station.

It should not cost you more than 25 Lei (Romanian currency) or 5 Euros from the Airport.

3. Where am I? Who answer to my call?

You are in Romania, the city of IASI, one of the 4 biggest towns after the capital Bucharest.

Your address during the Summer school (see the Area map and the City map attached):

One of the first steps at the reception is your distribution in a Group of minimum 25 participants.

Four Groups are thus formed: A, B, C, and D.

For each Group, an Animator is designated in order to answer to questions and to solve problems.

Any question and problem you encounter should be addressed firstly to the Animator you are distributed to, or to any other Animator present at the Help-desk.

4. Spatial immediate orientation in the Summer school perimeter.

Attached to this document you will find a small map of the surrounding area including (AREA MAP):

1. The building of the dormitory
2. The building of the canteen
3. The main building including the amphitheatre, the classes for courses, the rooms for work-shops
4. The sport field
5. The closest bank office in case you need an exchange office (09.00 to 17.00 on Monday to Friday)
6. The closest small shop for all kind of urgent purchases (opened late in the evening)
7. The closest restaurant & bar with a nice terrace “Casa Universitarilor Ieseni”
8. Carol I Boulevard – as the main orientation street close to the high school
9. “Alexandru Ioan Cuza” University – as the main orientation building close to the high school
10. A medical facility for medical consultation when it is needed.

5. First steps, first items received.

➤ *Badges*

At the reception you will receive a badge. Take care of it and wear it.

It is your attestation of participant to the Summer school in contacts with the local personnel.

It is useful too in situations you may encounter:

- in contacting the Animator designated to help you in problems you may encounter

The name and the phone number of the Animator designated for you are marked on the back of the badge.

The names and the phone numbers of three other Animators are marked as well on the back of the badge.

- in finding the location of the Summer school or in communicating with a taxi driver

You should wear the badge all the time you participate to organized events like courses, workshops, meals, excursions. The Professors, the Assistants, the organizers, as well as everybody else will communicate easier with you being able to see your name.

The badges are printed in 4 different colors corresponding to each of the four groups:

GROUP A – Blue **GROUP B – Orange**

GROUP C – Yellow **GROUP D – Green**

Each of the four Animators will wear a badge having the same color as the one marked on the participants badges distributed in the four groups.

The group letter and the badges color will orient you in finding the course or the workshops classes.

➤ *Can I change my group and the Animator?*

That’s not advised, giving the administrative difficulties implied by such changes.

Any problem related to this subject will be discussed with the Animators and the Organizers.

➤ *Welcome package*

You will sign a **Collective registration form** mentioning the date, hour of arrival, room number.

Individual registration form – this should be filled by you and returned to the welcoming personnel.

Transport reimbursement sheet – this should be filled by you and returned to the welcoming personnel in order for us to be able to reimburse the costs of your travel. Please read carefully the filling instructions on the back of the form. Attach the transport documents to this sheet (plain, train, bus, car).

You will also receive a folder with some materials like:

Welcome paper presenting the project, the activities of the Summer school and other information.

Summer school programme.

Courses materials: handbook, pens, paper. You will have to sign for receiving the course materials.

Area map marking the most important points near by (shop, exchange office, restaurant) as well as the main locations for the actions to take place inside the high school perimeter (dormitory, canteen, courses classes and amphitheatre, sport fields).

City map marking the main attractions in a walking distance (aprox. 10 Km).

6. Where do I sleep? Where do I eat?

➤ *Where do I sleep?*

You will be hosted at the dormitory of the National College “C. Negruzzi” (see AREA MAP)
In each room 2 participants will be accommodated.

The distribution of the participants in each room will be made respecting the order of arrivals and following the gender distribution. If you come in groups and you wish to be accommodated together, the Animators will do their best to satisfy the majority of your initial preferences.

➤ *Can I change the room?*

That’s not advised, giving the administrative difficulties implied by such changes.

Be aware that it will be impossible for us to respond to all individual demands regarding the re/distribution in rooms according to eventual friendships established during the Summer school.

➤ *Are there any room services provided?*

Be aware that the National College Dormitory is not a 100% hotel facility with room services, etc.

In each room you should find: 1 toilet, 2 beds, 1 table, 2 chairs, blankets, pillows, and sheets for 2 persons and one recycle bin. It is better to bring your own towels.

We will ensure the basic hygienic items like: soap, toilet paper, plastic bags for garbage.

Each participant should preserve the cleaning of the bedroom and bath room.

Other basic cleaning products will be available at the Help-desk and accessible on demand.

➤ *Can I have access to internet?*

Yes. There is free wireless access to internet in the campus. No password of access is needed.

Internet by cable is not available. If you don’t have your own laptop, you can still access the internet from by demanding to the Animators to allow you to use the laptop at the Help-desk.

➤ *Where do I eat?*

In the perimeter of the “Costache Negruzzi” high school there is a canteen (see AREA MAP).

The menu is relative standard and it is free for the participants.

The programme of the meals is marked on the Summer School Programme (see attached).

We advise you to respect this programme. We can not provide the meals outside this programme.

You can also eat in any other restaurant in the city on your own expenditure.

➤ *Can I cook my own meal?*

The canteen is closed outside the specified programme.

There are no cooking facilities in the dormitory rooms. You will not find a refrigerator. Sorry.

7. Transportation reimbursement

➤ *How much of the transport cost will be reimbursed?*

Transportation reimbursement will be made according to the project specifications and financial regulations of the European Commission.

As it was mentioned to all the participants, the reimbursement will cover the cost for transport

- in the limit of 50 Euros for the participants from Romania,
- in the limit of 300 Euros for the participants from other countries of European Union,
- in the limit of 450 Euros for the participants from the Balkans countries.

At this moment of the project we can reimburse only the costs for arrival to the Summer school. That is caused by the fact that we have to receive the original travel documents from you and keep them. Since the documents for return are not yet available or disposable from your part, at this time of the project we can not reimburse all the costs of your travel but only for the travel from your home country to the Summer school location, based on travel documents that you can give us in original.

The rest of the reimbursement will be sent to you by bank transfer/other mean together with the 100 Euros for the work as Ambassadors in your home country (distribution of 100 informative brochures). The cost for the travel back home together with the 100 Euros will be sent to you after receiving from your side, by post, the travel documents for turning back home in original, together with other documents filled by you on the Ambassador campaign.

➤ **Which is the procedure for reimbursement?**

In order to reimburse the costs of travel for arrival to the Summer school, you will have to fill out a form with **Transportation reimbursement sheet – arriving to the Summer school** following the instructions on the back of the form. Once you arrive to the Summer school, the Animators will ask you to fill such a form. Once completed, you should give it back to the Animator (Animators) together with the travel documents you bought on the way. Based on this evidence of travel costs and on the official exchange rate of the European Union, the project team will make the calculations regarding the amount of money we can reimburse to you during the Summer school.

In order to be recognized, the payment shall be confirmed by you by signing a specific form.

➤ **When will I receive the money for the travel costs I already paid?**

We will try to reimburse the costs of the travels to Summer school as fast as possible.

The probable programme of travel costs reimbursement:

- Sunday (22.07.2012) we will try to process the documents of reimbursement for 40 Romanian travelers. This is because they engaged the smallest costs and the transport documents are less numerous and easier to verify by the organizers.
- Monday evening, after the City tour, if the time is sufficient, we will deal with 20 participants from other states of the European Union.
- Tuesday evening, between 17.00 and 19.30 we will deal with the 40 participants from Balkans. Giving the big amount of documents and money to be processed, the reimbursement for these participants will take more time.

We will need your cooperation on this process by filling out the **Transportation reimbursement sheet** as clear and as soon as you can after your arrival to the Summer school.

8. The help desk – 4 groups & 4 Animators:

The Help-desk is created to answer to your questions, to receive your demands and your complaints in order to solve them. Usually, the Help-desk is populated by at least one Animator.

The Help-desk is opened between 8:00 and 20:00 from Monday morning to the moment all participants leave the Summer school.

One Animator will sleep in the Dormitory even over night in one room which will be communicated to you on your arrival. This measure is taken to ensure assistance 24 hours/day to the participants.

However, over night, the Animator will be disturbed only in cases of justified emergency.

All Animators will be accessible through the Help-desk in the important moments of each day.

Outside these moments, the Animators will be available to the Help-desk by rotation. So, even if you don't find the Animator designated for your group, you can address to anyone else present there and wearing a badge of Animator or of Organizer.

You should do the same on any moment of the Summer school when the Animator designated for your group is not available or in the area.

EXCEPTIONS: There are some moments when no Animator will be available on the Help desk:

- first minutes of each course and each work-shop when all of them will do their jobs in classes.
- examination and awarding sessions when all of them will do their jobs in classes.

Any way, in such moments you will not need them because you will be also in classes.

- free time events which are not free for the Animators. They will accompany the groups in the City tour and in the one day excursion in Bucovina (a picturesque place).

In case you decide not to participate to such events, you should communicate this decision to the Animators and solve all problems before the departure of the four groups.

In such circumstances you can call the Project manager for any emergency.

- communicating more sensitive problems to the management team
- communicating to you all kind of information related to the organization of Summer school

- assisting the professors in classes (filling lists of presence, making photos etc.)
- enlisting the participants, organizing and supervising the groups in the optional events like The city tour, The parties, The film watching, The sportive event, The excursion to Bucovina.
- completion of all other administrative and logistical jobs related to the participants.

Please communicate with them any problem you have.

Please help them complete their tasks by according them maximum of attention.

10. What happens during the Courses?

Each morning, after the breakfast you will go to the courses.

Courses are organized in 4 classes especially designated and marked for each group A, B, C, D.

1. *Bringing security all over Europe*
2. *The EU Neighbourhood Policy*
3. *The price of the EU Enlargement and the Balkans integration*
4. *Clash of civilization: the rise of European citizen*

The Professors are in charge with the 4 courses. Each of the four groups will attend each of the four courses by rotation on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

The Animators will keep the evidence of your presence to the courses.

The courses attendance is mandatory for all the participants.

11. What happens to the Work-shops?

Each day, after lunch you will go to the courses classes.

2 of the workshops are organized in 2 of the courses classes.

These classes are especially marked to be easily identified.

1. *Work-shop Europe in images!*
2. *Work-shop Traditions as part of Europe!*

The third work-shop is organized in the canteen of the high school.

3. *Work-shop Europe in the kitchen!*

All material needed for the work-shop will be available there. Do not wear your best cloths there.

Each group will participate to this work-shop by rotation starting with group B.

The fourth work-shop will take place outside the building, in special places around Iasi city.

4. *Work-shop You and EU*

Each group will participate to this work-shop by rotation.

The meeting point will be in the court yard of the high school at 14.00 o'clock each day.

A special mini-bus will take you in a trip together with the designated Assistant and Animator.

The Assistants are in charge with the 4 work-shops. Each of the four groups will attend each of the four work-shops by rotation on the after-noon of Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

The Animators will keep the evidence of your presence to the work-shops.

The work-shops attendance is mandatory for all the participants.

12. What happens during the Evaluation session?

All participants will participate to the evaluation session on Friday morning. The evaluation will take place in the four classes where you attended the courses.

The evaluation is both sided:

- a small test which consists in questions regarding topics from the 4 courses you attended.
- a questionnaire which consists of questions intended to evaluate the Summer school organization.

NOTA BENE: after the evaluation session, the project team will present you the activities to be done once you reach your home land: the Ambassadors campaign and the brochures distribution.

13. What is the Round table?

Some of the participants to the Summer school are members of NGO-s. The status of member of NGO will be marked by you on the Individual registration form filled by you upon arrival.

The NGO members, as well as other participants will be invited to take parte at a Round table in one of the classes of the high school in order to discuss NGO problems and possible partnerships for the future. This event is not mandatory. The Animators will keep an evidence of those wanting to participate.

14. What is the Awarding session?

On the awarding session all the participants will receive a diploma proving their attendance to the Summer school. On this occasion, the official closing of the Summer school will take place.

The event will take place in the Amphitheatre.

15. What are the Free time events?

During the Summer school there is free time available. The free time is for your own disposal.

However, the organizers propose you some events to participate to.

➤ *Iasi City tour*

Monday afternoon, at 17.30 we will meet in the court yard of the high school in order to participate to a city tour by bus and by foot. We will have a qualified guide with us.

We provided nothing on this tour like water, juices or ice-cream. At 8.30 the dinner waits for us.

We suppose that every body will join us in this excursion. However, if you decide not to come in the city tour, please inform your Animator so he/she could know that you are not coming and that the group doesn't have to wait for you in vain. Those who are late to the meeting point more than 10 minutes, risk loosing the event.

➤ *Film watching*

Wednesday evening, at 17.30 we will meet in the amphitheatre to watch a movie together. The movie title is "California Dreamin'", a tail from Balkans.

You should contact the Animators in order to enlist yourself for participating to event. This is for us to know if we should wait you at the beginning of the movie or not. Those who delay more than 10 minutes risk loosing the beginning of the event.

➤ *2 Parties*

The two parties on Tuesday and Thursday evening beginning with 21.00 o'clock will consist in going together in a nearby disco-bar. One or two Animators will accompany those interested.

All cost related to entrance (1-2 Euros) and other consumption will be covered by you.

You should contact your Animator in order to enlist yourself for participating to event. This is for us to know if we should wait you at the meeting point or not. Those who are late at the meeting point more than 10 minutes, risk missing the departure to the parties.

➤ *Sportive event*

One sportive event will be organized on Friday 27.07.2012 at noon (or after-noon depending on weather).

In order to organize this event, the Animators will make a list of those who wish to participate to:

- football game
- basket-ball game
- handball game

You should contact your Animator in order to enlist yourself for participating to event.

They will need to know soon those who want to participate in order to do the necessary arrangements.

➤ *Excursion in Bucovina*

This is a one day long trip in the North-East of Romania, a picturesque area called BUCOVINA.

You will see old monasteries, some of them entered in the UNESCO Patrimony.

We will take our break-fast at the high school canteen.

We will take lunch on a restaurant on the way.

The dinner will be served in Iasi, in a restaurant in town.

There will be water to drink in the bus carrying us. If you want juices or fruits on the way, you will have to take them with you or buy them on the programmed stops.

We suppose that every body will join us in this excursion. However, if you decide not to come in this excursion, please inform your Animator so he/she could know that you are not coming and that the group doesn't have to wait for you in vain. Those who are late to the meeting point more than 15 minutes, risk loosing the excursion.

16. Free time for yourself?

Iasi city is remarkable by the historical heritage and its 5 universities for humanistic, technical, medical, agrarian and arts studies. Usually, there are some 50.000 students in Iasi. But now it is holiday.

Yet, there are a lot of nice people in Iasi who can answer to your questions in English.

If you choose to visit the city, it is very easy to do it by foot or by bus.

Attached to this guide you can find a CITY MAP where there are marked some main attractions of the city in a 10 Km area. The main attractions are spread on a simple line marked on the map.

1. **Carol I Boulevard** that is the main road climbing the “Copou” Hill (North-West on the map).

The high school is located very close to the Carol I Boulevard, next to “Al.I. Cuza” University.

The boulevard ends up next to the Exposition and Botanic Garden (points 2 and 1 on the map).

The boulevard ends downhill on the “Mihai Eminescu” Square (points 6, 7, 8 and 9 on the map). You will easily recognize the “Mihai Eminescu” Square by the major public works that are done there.

2. **Lapusneanu Street to “Unirii” (Union’s) Square.** It is a small, pedestrian street, linking the “Mihai Eminescu” Square to “Unirii” (Union’s) Square. The “Unirii” Square is the historical center of the city. You will easily recognize it by the doves that fly over it. (points 10, 11, 12).

3. **“Stefan cel Mare” (Stefan the Great) Boulevard** that links the “Unirii” Square with the “Culturii” (Cultural) Palace. Once you entered the boulevard, you will see the towers of the Palace ahead of you. “Stefan cel Mare” Boulevard is one of the main arteries of the city. It is closed for cars and opened to pedestrian walks in weekends. (points 13 – 21 on your map).

4. **“Culturii” (Cultural) Palace and Palas Shopping Park.** Good for the Iasi city but bad for you is that the “Culturii” Palace is closed for rehabilitation. You can still visit the surroundings. Behind the Palace you will find Palas Shopping Park. There is the newest architectural part of the city, opened two month ago. You will find there a nice park, terraces and ... of course, a lot of shopping buildings (Points 22, 23 on your map).

17. What is mandatory during the Summer school?

- a. Presence to courses. Presence papers will be signed on each day.
- b. Presence to workshops. Presence papers will be signed on each day.
- c. Presence to evaluation and to awarding event. Presence papers will be signed on this events.
- d. Documents filling when demanded by the Animators. We have to gather paper proofs.
- e. Keeping contact with your Group Animator during the Summer school for all problems.
- f. Being polite and respectful, having consideration for all the participants (and the organizers), no matter their sex, country, language, religion, ethnicity, political and sexual orientations.
- g. **IT IS MANDATORY TO HAVE FUN TOGETHER.**

18. What is optional during the Summer school?

- h. City tour organized on Monday after-noon,
- i. Participation to the 2 Parties on Tuesday and Thursday evening,
- j. Participation to the sportive event on Friday noon,
- k. Participation to the Romanian night dinner on Friday evening,
- l. Participation to the excursion in Bucovina on Saturday.

19. What is forbidden during the Summer school?

- m. Bringing and drinking alcohol inside the high school perimeter is forbidden. There are plenty of bars in the surrounding area. Drunken people are not tolerated. Drugs are also forbidden.
- n. Making loud noises inside the high school perimeter during the night disturbing the other participants and personnel is also forbidden.
- o. It is forbidden to leave the Summer school before its ending.

Given that the last mandatory event is the Awarding session on Friday, the 27 of July, no participant should leave before that event. In any case, nobody will leave the Summer school without communicating his or her decision to the Animators and then to the Project Manager. We have to make sure that all administrative papers are well filled and that the participant that leave knows and understand what will be his task at home as an EU Ambassador. We want thank you for coming and say good-by to you any way.

20. What follows after the Summer school?

➤ *Instruction on the actions following the Summer school*

Friday, 27.07.12, after the evaluation session, around 10.00 o'clock, there will be a discussion on the next steps to be completed after leaving the Summer school. All questions regarding this matter will be answered at that moment. Some paper forms will be given to you in order to complete the Ambassadors Campaign in your countries (Report forms, Lists of distribution, etc.)

➤ *The trip back home*

After the Summer school, the participants must return to their home (where they began their trip to the Summer school). It is preferable that they follow the same route as that used for coming. This will make easier the process of reimbursement of costs.

➤ *Reimbursement of travel costs back-home*

No travel costs for travel back home will be paid in advance. All travel costs will be reimbursed for each participant by bank transfer/other means after the management team will receive by post the **Transportation reimbursement sheet – leaving the Summer school** for the trip back home in original together with the documents proving the expenditures (bus, train, car, plain tickets) in original.

➤ *Ambassadors Campaign and 100 Euros*

In order to complete the Ambassadors campaign, the project team will send to you by post 100 informative brochures together with the forms to be used in the distribution of these brochures.

- 1 campaign report will be filled by you after distributing the brochures using a standardized form
- 5 lists of distribution of the brochures will be filled with 100 signatures from 100 citizens in your country, chosen as you please.


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AREA MAP




